

Does the mobile base station need to be powered

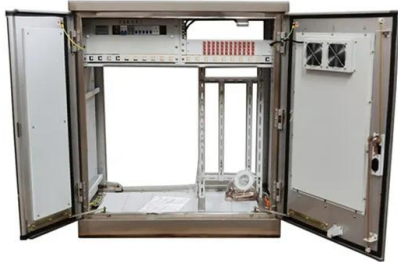


Overview

Yes, a mobile CB can be used as a base station. The power supply should have an output between 12 to 14 volts DC. From the reading i have done, my understanding is that all my equipment in the shack needs to be connected to a single point ground which runs a ground wire outside to the ground rod. When i connect it to a DC power supply in the shack, does the mobile unit need to be grounded?

From what i can see. Base stations are required to enable mobile phone communication, including calls and data transfer. They consist of different electronic components and antennas and can be located on masts, on rooftops, or on the outside or inside of buildings. Backhaul: Although this is not strictly part of the cellular base station, it interfaces directly with it to. A cell site, cell phone tower, cell base tower, or cellular base station is a cellular-enabled mobile device site where antennas and electronic communications equipment are placed (typically on a radio mast, tower, or other raised structure) to create a cell, or adjacent cells, in a cellular.
