Developed through a strategic partnership between OneWeb Angola and Eutelsat. French satellite operator Eutelsat, through its subsidiary OneWeb, has inaugurated a new ground station in Luanda-Bengo, Angola, as part of a long-term push to expand satellite connectivity across Africa. 3G coverage reaches about 90-92% of the population; 4G coverage.
