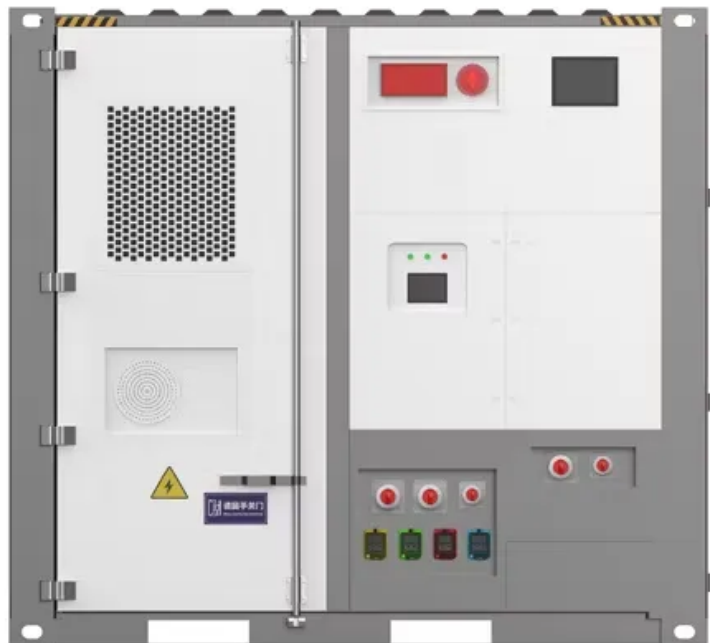


Malawi battery performance



Overview

By improving voltage levels and reducing power outages, the project will significantly enhance the reliability of clean energy for grid-connected houses, industries, and critical public infrastructure, including hospitals, schools, and water supply systems. The Alliance is helping the government-owned Electricity Supply Corporation of Malawi (ESCOM) deploy and operate a 20 MW battery energy storage system (BESS). This battery system will strengthen Malawi's grid and enable a far steadier uptake of variable power from renewables. 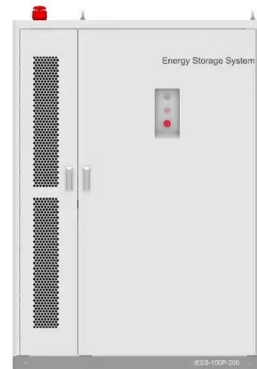
