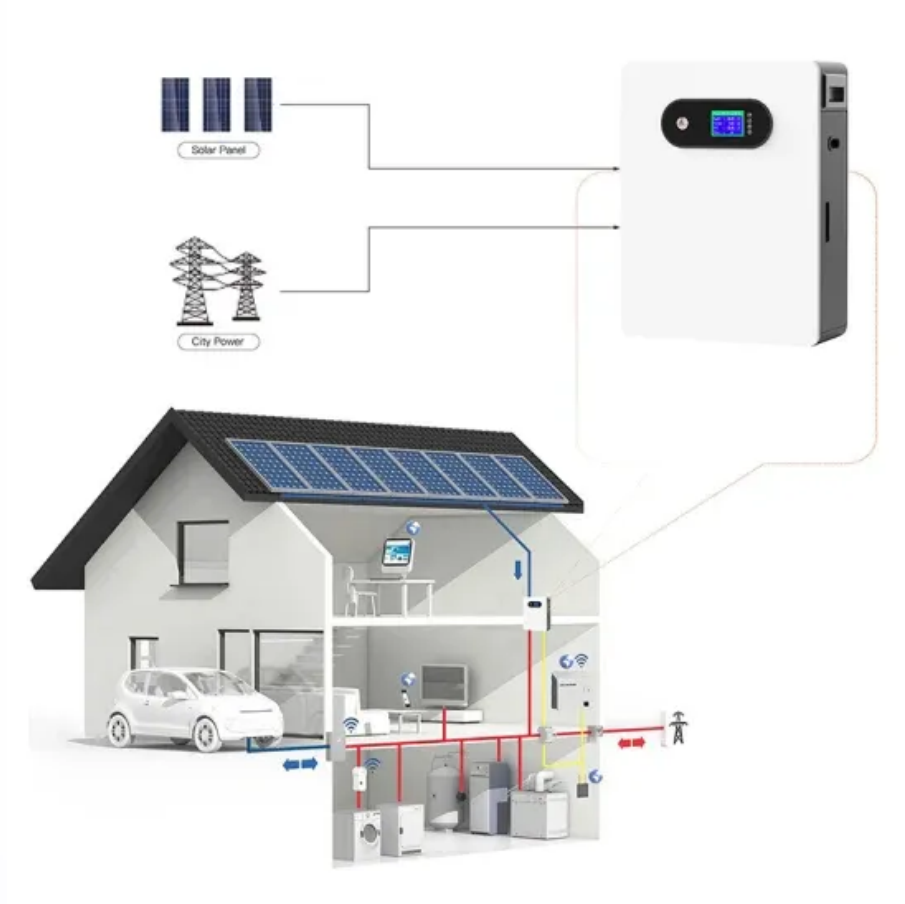


Where are the Finnish Telecom base stations



Overview

A total of 47 base stations for satellite positioning have been placed across the country. Together, they form the FinnRef network, which is maintained by the National Land Survey of Finland (NLS). Data communication between the mobile phone and the base station is carried out using radio waves. There are several smaller providers which may have independent networks in smaller areas, but are generally dependent on rented networks. There is a great variety of cellular providers. By September 2023, 71% of Finnish households had gigabit fixed broadband (1 Gbps) and 78% had 100 Mbps+ speeds, driven by 61% fiber access by end-2023. Finland aims for every household to have at least 100 Mbps connectivity (upgradeable to 1 Gbps) by 2025, with a national plan to reach full 1 Gbps. Coverage depends on the user's location in relation to the nearest base station.
