A solar inverter or photovoltaic (PV) inverter is a type of power inverter which converts the variable direct current (DC) output of a photovoltaic solar panel into a utility frequency alternating current (AC) that can be fed into a commercial electrical grid or used by a local, off-grid electrical. He is known as the "Father of Invention," for the 1,093 patents he acquired in his 84 years, including the phonograph, the incandescent light bulb, and motion picture cameras. The idea of using grid control in combination with phase retard co modulate AC power originated with ochers a out four years earlier. 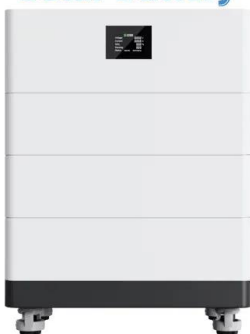
